

# Crossroads Kids Staff

## Before You come:

- Sick staff members should not return to work until they have met the [criteria to discontinue home isolation](#).
- Communicate to Directors if you, as a staff, develop symptoms, please stay in touch with Ministry Directors if or when you start to feel sick.
- We will be asking all individuals about any symptoms (primarily fever, cough, difficulty breathing or other signs of illness within the last 24 hours) – that they, or someone in their homes, might have and whether they have had any exposure to another individual with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 cases.
- Please arrive with enough time to be in your class ready for kids 15 minutes before service.

## While you're here:

Take [everyday preventive actions](#) to prevent the spread of respiratory illness.

- [Wash hands](#) often with soap and water. If soap and water are not readily available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
- Remember to supervise young children when they use hand sanitizer to prevent swallowing alcohol.
- [Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces](#).
- [Cover cough and sneezes](#).
- Cover your mouth and nose with a [cloth face covering](#) when interacting with kids and parents in the Crossroads kids areas.
- Cloth face coverings should NOT be put on babies and children under age two because of the danger of suffocation.

It is important to adhere to the following distancing guidelines:

- Children should remain in groups as small as possible
  - . It is important to keep the same children and teacher or staff with each group and include children from the same family in the same group, to the greatest extent possible.
- Extend the indoor environment to outdoors, and bring the class outside, weather permitting.
- Open windows to ventilate facilities before and after children arrive.
  - Arrange developmentally appropriate activities for smaller group activities and rearrange furniture and play spaces to maintain 6-foot separation, when possible.
- Find creative ways to use yarn, masking tape, or other materials for children to create their own space.

**Ratios and Capacity Requirements: no longer a 10 Children max for any group**

The state mandated ratios are less than our Crossroads Church policy on staffing which requires 2 kids staff per classroom. In the latest guidance from CA.gov covid regarding childcare providers, there are no mandatory class size limits for children.

**We will be implementing our Welcome Station – Check In**

Parents need to accompany all children to the welcome center and social distance while waiting in line to check-in their child.

We will scan for fever

We will ask questions about sickness and possible exposure

We will sign them into their class.

This is also where your child will be picked up

**We will be encouraging the use of masks.**

Buds, Treehouse and TreeTops will be encouraged to use masks as per the guidelines and in similarity with what would be expected if they remained in the auditorium.

Sprouts class will not be wearing masks, we are not allowed to put masks on children 2 years old and younger. And this class is made of 2 and 3 years old.
